The New York City Board of Education is seeking English-speaking teachers of Mathematics, Science (Biology, Chemistry, and Physics), Spanish, and Special Education for the 2002-2003 school year.

Accepted candidates will be required to serve in the New York City public schools for two consecutive years, subject to satisfactory service.

All applicants must either hold a Magister degree with pedagogical training or a degree from a Pedagogical Academy in the designated subject area.

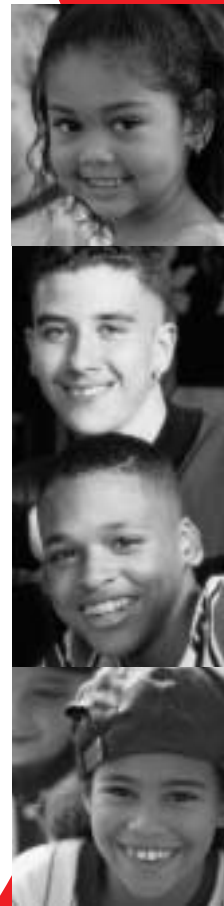
